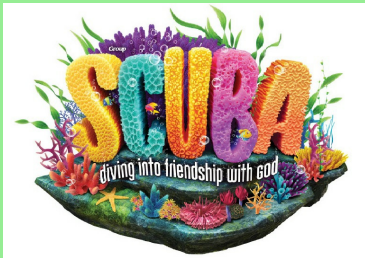
Prayer Chain

Contemplative Prayer Group of Northeast Wisconsin

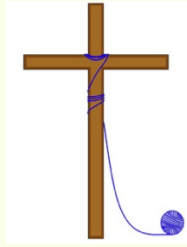

EPH is a Green Bay area 501(c)(3) organization whose mission is to “provide safety, stability, and solutions for families with children who are homeless or at risk of homelessness.” It owns 37 homes and employs a staff of 9 to support families in 3 programs: Transitional Housing (TH), Long-Term Supportive Housing (LTSH), and homelessness prevention. Altogether, in 2023, EPH served 60 families in its TH and LTSH programs, which included a combined 162 children.

Ginny Brand serves as Unit Coordinator for “Isaiah Lower,” the nickname of the Transitional Housing Unit St. Anne’s maintains. Ginny and other St. Anne’s volunteers helped clean and prepare the home for families moving into it.

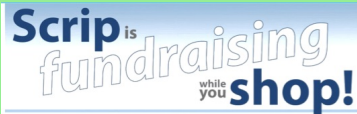

Scrip Order Form



R means Reload – and fewer fees!

Do you love to help St. Anne's by using Scrip cards for your regular purchases but are tired of buying a new one every time you use up the balance? Try reloading funds so you can keep using your card over and over.

Not every business offers the option to reload a card – the ones that do have an (R) next to them on the order form. If your card has a round R sticker on it, you can add money to it and keep using it. And use of these reloaded cards cuts down on Scrip fees for St. Anne's.

You can reload a card by going online and using the RaiseRight app or letting your Scrip team know what you'd like to add.

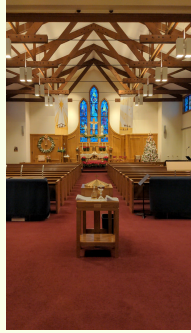
If you reload using the RaiseRight app, the refilled amount is ready to use right away. You will need to pay a small fee for using your bank account or credit card.

If the Scrip team reloads it, the amount will be added on Sunday. For the Scrip team to reload we need the card number on the back just one time.

You can purchase Scrip cards after church services or on our website and use them like cash in store or online. St. Anne's benefits by obtaining them at a discount and earning on each card. And as always, if you don't see a card for a business you go to, just ask – we may be able to get one for you.

The deadline to order is 2 pm every Sunday.

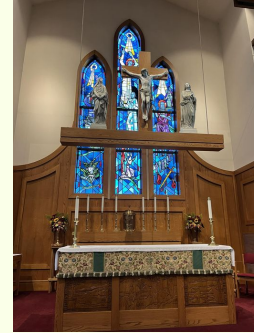

Worship

Altar Guild

The purpose of the altar guild is to assist the clergy. In general terms, the duty of the altar guild is to ready those things necessary for the celebration of the Eucharist and the observance of the other sacraments and offices of the church.

Usually two members are assigned to the weekend. They decide when to meet to set up the service for Sunday. Historically on Saturday at 9am.

Members are typically scheduled once or twice a month. More often on holidays such as Christmas and Easter. Set up the altar for services with communion scheduled and take down and clean up after.
