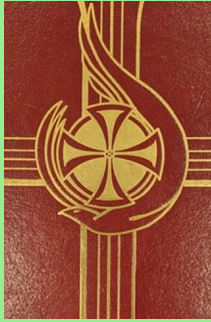


## Prayer Warriors

## Contemplative Prayer Group of Northeast Wisconsin

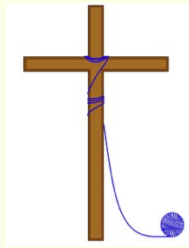

### Community Impact

Thank you for your continued support as a partnership church. Your prayers, volunteer hours, and financial contributions are helping families experiencing homelessness reach self-sufficiency. With your support, EPH has been able to provide 55 families – including 150 children – with housing and case management through our transitional housing and long-term supportive housing programs so far this year. We have also provided an additional 31 families with emergency rental assistance, budget counseling, and case management support through our eviction prevention program to help them avoid losing their housing and develop a plan for long-term stability.
